



A mais típica praia portuguesa está localizada no litoral centro do país, a cerca de 100 km de Lisboa e 230 km do Porto. Protegida na base do seu imponente promontório, a Nazaré, de ruas estreitas perpendiculares ao mar, encanta os visitantes pela sua beleza natural.

Antiga terra de pescadores e mareantes, a Vila é constituída por três núcleos populacionais distintos: Praia - de longo areal dourado, animada e tradicional; Sítio - local de culto e peregrinação, associado ao milagre da Nossa Senhora da Nazaré e D. Fuas Roupinho; e Pederneira - primeira morada de pescadores e calafates, onde existiu no século XVI um dos mais prósperos estaleiros navais do país.

Do Sítio, no alto do promontório, a 110 metros de altitude, o visitante pode contemplar o mais belo cenário marítimo português. Deve ainda visitar a Ermida da Memória e o Santuário da Nossa Senhora da Nazaré, descer até ao Forte de S. Miguel Arcanjo e deslumbrar-se com a vista. Pode também visitar a Praia do Norte, selvagem e tranquila, rodeada de dunas e pinhais, local preservado e ecológico ideal para longos passeios à beira mar, para a pesca desportiva e para o surf. Village of Nazaré
