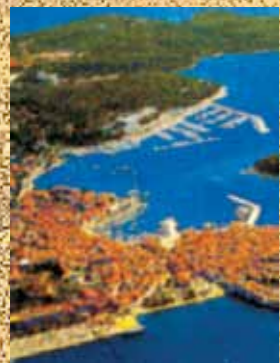

Jules Verne the father of science fiction, in search of unique places for his novels, chose Rovinj as a setting for some chapters of his novel "Mathias Sandorf".

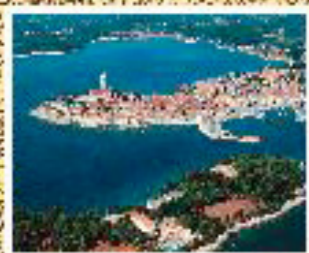
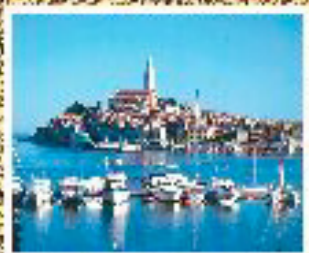
ROVINJ

This town developed in late antiquity as an island and it was mentioned for the first time as Rubiniun. Small in area the configuration of the island conditioned the building of the settlement with small houses placed tightly together in narrow

steep streets, vaulted passages and small squares. The walls protect the town from both the north and the south and the people used to enter the town through one of the seven gates. The Rovinj began to extend outside its city walls at the end of the 17th century.

The old part of the town was connected with the new by filling in the channel between island and mainland in 1763. Today Rovinj has about 14000 inhabitants and a valuable cultural heritage preserved through its stormy history. Rovinj had a contract with the port of Dubrovnik in 14 century for trading.
