Chania and the Municipal Port Fund

The new Port Fund offer a pleasant environment to enjoy the moments in the town and to help you prepare the sail from the marina to Archipelagos and to enjoy the beauty of the Cretan coast line.

The services you can find in the marina including fuel station, Oil Deposit (via order), water and electricity supplies systems. The Marina is capable of accommodating 110 small crafts (7-10 meters) and 20 big crafts (10-45 meters) and it is located in the old harbour of Chania.

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
